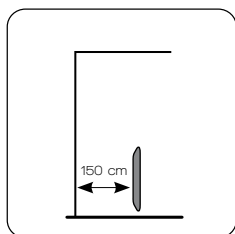
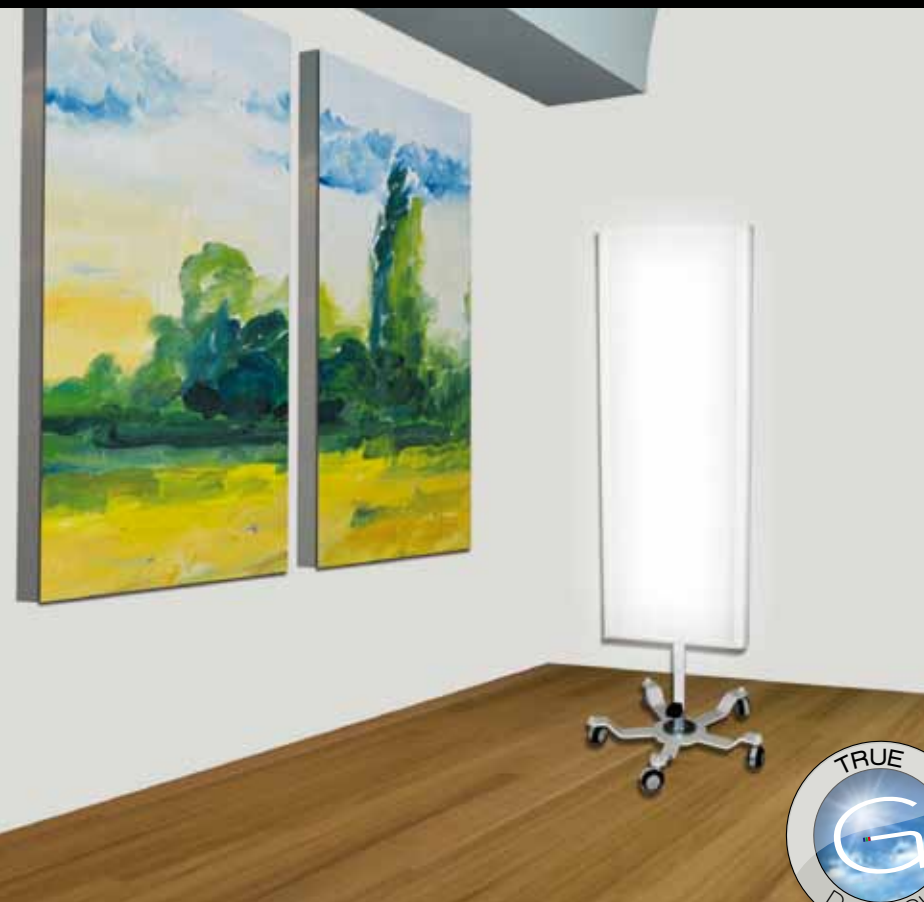
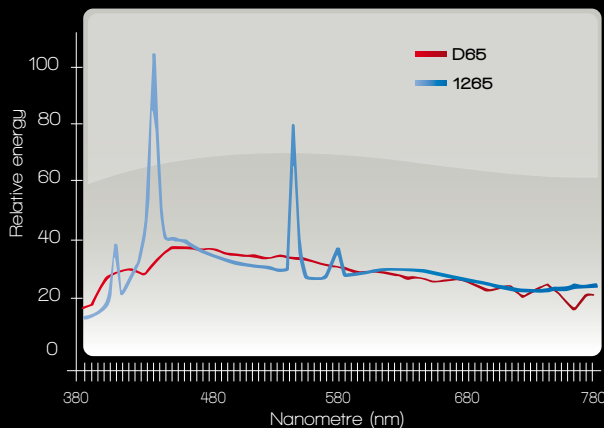

TRUE DAYLIGHT

Our brain has been formatted by the natural daylight under which it is the most efficient.

The specificity of Gamain lightings is their capacity to recreate this daylight thanks to a mix of different light sources. Gamain daylight is characterized by a complete and well-balanced spectral curve that tends to be superposed on the curve of the D65 illuminant as defined by the International Commission of Illumination (CIE).

Thus, the spectrum of Gamain daylight is more complete, which avoids any chromatic adaptation efforts and this way, eye's troubles. The eyestrain is reduced. This light, well-balanced onto the entire visible spectrum enables to appreciate efficiently and precisely the different parameters of the colour.
